Driving licence

Maximum speed:

10 km/h	no driving licence required / minimum age 16 years (14 years and older with driving licence cat. M or G)
20 km/h	no driving licence required / minimum age 16 years (14 years and older with driving licence cat. M or G)
30 km/h	Category M (moped) If you voluntarily waive category B, you can request a category M permit from the Road Traffic Office.
45 km/h	Category A1 (Category B will not do. A1 is mandatory) (Acquisition of category A1 possible from the age of 15)

Licence plate

Maximum speed:

10 km/h	no licence plate
20 km/h	licence plate for mopeds
30 km/h	licence plate for mopeds
45 km/h	licence plate for small motorbikes and light motor vehicles

Helmet obligation

Helmets are not compulsory up to the maximum speed of 30 km/h.
Wearing a motorbike helmet is mandatory for a maximum speed of 45 km/h.
